SEMINARS / CONFERENCES / WORKSHOPS / GUEST LECTURES ORGANIZED DURING THE YEAR

GUEST LECTURES: A total of 19 Guest lectures were arranged for the benefit of the students. These events are valuable because they offer real-world insights and current trends from experts from the Industry which helps the students in understanding the current developments in the industry so that they can focus on those developments.

WORKSHOPS / SEMINAR / CONFERENCE ORGANISED: Organizing 22 workshops/seminars/conferences in different array of events not only enhances the academic experience but also actively engages participants in professional development and knowledge exchange. The attendees gained knowledge in the latest development in various fields.

INDUSTRIAL VISITS: Industrial visits are indeed a valuable component of educational programs, offering students practical insights into industry operations and practices. In the year 2021 – 22 the students have visited 4 different industries. They gained practical knowledge in the areas of their interest.

FDP'S AND MDP'S: The faculties have attended 21 FDP's and MDP's in the year 2021 – 22.

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PLACEMENT DETAILS: 89 students of NSB Bangalore are placed in different industries with a decent package.

INTERNSHIP DETAILS: All 117 have finished their internships in various industries based on the specializations opted for by them and have submitted their reports to the college, which in turn submitted to the university as a part of their course.

CLUB ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED: 11 club activities are organized in the year 2021 – 22 by various clubs, including a vaccination drive, inauguration of E-Cell, and Onam celebrations.

CONCLUSION: The year 2021-22 saw a high amount of 17 MoUs being signed between NSB and various universities in India and abroad. The year has also been highly rewarding to students, faculty and management as NSB held many fruitful activities. During the year NSB organized 22 seminars/conferences/workshops on various themes and speakers shared their experiences and knowledge with our students and faculty. The faculty also published ten research papers during the year. During the year, the students had four industrial visits to gain valuable first-hand knowledge of corporate working.

NSB also organized extension activities like blood donation camps for the benefit of society.

NSB always takes pride in celebrating Independence Day, Republic Day and Gandhi Jayanthi and this year was no exception. NSB also celebrated cultural events like “Maha Sankranti”, and “Ganesh Chaturthi”. We also strongly believe in the rich traditions of women and “Women’s’ Day” was celebrated with great fervor. The NSB is a confluence of states as we get students from almost 28 Indian states and every year, we celebrate the “Cultural Immersion” day with lots of enthusiasm.

Very importantly, 2019-21, saw our students excelling in education also with 99% pass per centage. It is also a proud moment for us as 61 students out of a total of 117 students passed out with First Class with Distinction. This also ensured that 89 out of our batch of 117 students have been placed in various industries.
